Affected products

Lea Bunk Beds with bookcases

Product description

This recall involves Lea Covington and Hannah Collections style bunk beds with bookcases.

They were sold in twin over twin and full over full sizes, with accessories including a bookcase. The Covington Collection has a cherry finish, and the Hannah Collection has a white finish. The Lea name and model information is printed on a label attached to the backside of the headboard on the bottom bunk and on the back of the bookcase.

Hazard identified

A vertical space is created when a bed with a bookcase is not assembled correctly. This results in an entrapment hazard.

Health Canada has not received any reports of consumer incidents or injuries top Canadians related to the use of these recalled beds.

Number sold

Approximately 26 affected beds were sold in Canada at various retailers.

Approximately 500 affected beds were sold in the United States at various retailers.

Time period sold

The affected products were sold in Canada from December 2011 until March 2014.

The affected products were sold in the United States from September 2011 until March 2014.

Manufactured in Vietnam.
